### **Seasonal High Temperatures from March to May**

Do remind your child to also inform the teacher should he/she feel unwell. Parents may wish to apply sunscreen for their children before coming to school.

# Ban of Mobile Phones and/or Smart Watches within School Premises

As part of SG Grow Well to encourage all Singaporean children to adopt healthier lifestyles, schools have implemented measures to manage students' use of mobile phones and smart watches within school premises.

To ensure students remain focused on learning, students with mobile phones and/or smart watches are reminded to adhere to the school rules and regulations. Mobile phones must be always switched off and the communication capabilities of smart watches must be disabled within the school premises. The use of these devices for contacting parents is only permitted outside school or at the school foyer after school dismissal.

These devices should not be brought into the examination rooms. Photography, video and voice recordings and gaming are strictly prohibited within the school premises. We seek your understanding that if the devices are used inappropriately, they will be confiscated and be kept by the school until a parent comes to claim it. Your support in reinforcing this at home is greatly appreciated, as we work together to create the best possible learning environment for our
