Temperature Taking Exercise (TTEx) 8th July & 9th July 2025

Do help your children prepare for the exercise by reminding them to bring their Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) to school on both days. During the first Temperature Taking Exercise in January this year, we issued the ODTs to our P1 students and P1 teachers have kept them for safekeeping. Parents of P2 to P6 students should check that your child's ODT is in working condition and if it is lost or damaged. ODTs can be purchased from the school's bookshop. Do contact your child's form teachers should you have any queries.

2025 P1 Registration Exercise - Phase 1 Registration

Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2019 and 1 January 2020 (both dates inclusive) and has a sibling currently studying in our school.

For the 2025 P1 Registration Exercise, parents who are registering your younger child under Phase 1 are to register during the Phase 1 registration period from 1st July 2025, 9 am to 3rd July 2025, 4.30 pm through the P1 Registration Portal.
