In the lead-up to National Day, our Recess Programme was filled with excitement. From *Chope Master* to *Giant Flag Eraser* and *Icons of Singapore Toss*, students enjoyed three uniquely local games. They also got creative at the *All Things Singapore* badge booth and, together with staff, contributed to the SG60 Collage Mural, celebrating 60 years of unity, resilience and progress. On Friday, 8th August 2025, we began our National Day celebrations with a Combined Observance Ceremony with Tampines Secondary School. The Scouts and Brownies marched proudly with the secondary school's contingents. Back in classrooms, students shared their hopes for Singapore's future. Our concert lit up the stage with six performances – Guzheng, Malay Dance, Indian Dance, MK@TPPS, Choir and Modern Dance – each marking a decade of our nation's journey. The performances were met with overwhelming cheers and support from parents, students, School Leaders, teachers and the general public. “Save the Earth” Collaborative Mural Series with Residence of Tampines Park

On 31st August 2025, our students proudly took part in Tampines Park Clean Day, held in conjunction with SG Clean Day, a national initiative where sweeping in public spaces was paused to encourage residents to take responsibility for their surroundings. The event, graced by Grassroots’ Adviser, Mr Masagos Zulkifli, Minister for Social and Family Development, brought together the community in the spirit of care for the environment.

As part of the programme, our students joined residents and volunteers in a litter-picking exercise, with waste sorted to identify recyclables. This was followed by an NEA sharing on “*Recycling Right*”, which stressed the urgency of practising the 3Rs—Reduce, Reuse, Recycle. Students learnt the three key steps—**Check, Clean, Recycle**—and participated by practicing proper recycling such as flattening milk boxes and cartons.

The event concluded with the unveiling of the ‘Save the Earth’ mural, symbolising eco-stewardship. Tampines Primary School is proud to have contributed to this initiative, with the mural thoughtfully designed by our students and beautifully brought to life by members of the Art Club. Beyond showcasing their creativity, this experience also provided authentic opportunities for our students to exercise leadership, collaborate with the community, and grow as future community leaders committed to building a cleaner, greener Singapore.



PSLE Listening Comprehension (LC) Examination – Tuesday, 16th September 2025

The PSLE Listening Comprehension Examination for P6 students will be on Tuesday, 16th September 2025. P6 students are to report punctually to the school hall at 8 a.m. Students who are exempted from Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) will report at 10.15 a.m. at the school hall.

P1 to P5 students do not report to school that day. They will be doing home-based learning.
